STEP-BY-STEP PATTERN GUIDE

Step 1: Create the Base Panel

Foundation Double Crochet (FDC)



Simple Ripple/Wavy Pattern



Row 1: FDC count 2 crarts
Row 1: FDC simple ripple court tions
Row 1: FDC count
Row 2-N: simple ripple using DCs each atch is corroned using DCs.

Step 2: Add Scalloped Border



Single Crochet (SC) Half Double Crochet (HDC) Picot Stitch

(SC, HDC, 3DC, HDC, SC)

Step 3: Create Appliques

Lavender Stalks



Popcorn Stitch (PC) Chain (CH) Slip Stitch (SL ST)

Make a long chain in make. Work the PC and 3 loops on hook, in down the stalk. Work in PC and CH down the stalk CH down the stalk.

Small Flowers



Magic Ring (MR) Cluster Stitch (CL)

MR:
(CH3, CL, CH3, SL ST in MR) x for petals.
(CH3, CL, CH3, SL ST in MR) x 5 for petals.

Leaves

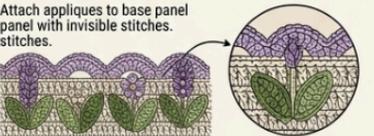


Single Crochet (SC) Double Crochet (DC)

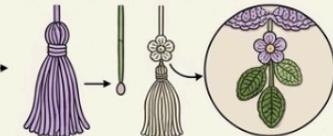
CH 6.
Work down chain on C 6.
Work down chain:
(SC, HDC, DC, HDC, SC)

Step 4: Assembly

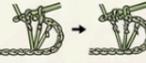
Attach appliques to base panel with invisible stitches.



Step 5: Tassels & Dangles

 **PROJECT COMPLETE**

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Materials & Tools

Yarn (Sport Weight #2, 100% Cotton recommended):

- Natural (base)
- Lavender (stalks)
- Lilac (border & petals)
- White (petals)
- Dark Purple (petals)
- Spring Green (leaves)

Hooks:

- 2.25 mm (US B/1)
- 3.0 mm (US D/3) for base

Tools:

- Scissors 
- Yarn needle
- Measuring tape

Finished Size

- Width: 32 inches (81 cm)
- Height (without tassels): 14 inches (35 cm)
- Tassel length: 4 inches (10 cm)

Step 1: Create the Base Panel

Start with the **3.0 mm hook** and Natural yarn.

Foundation Row

- Make a **foundation double crochet (FDC)** row to desired width (approx. 32 inches)

Row 1

- Work **FDC across the row**

Row 2 and Beyond (Ripple Pattern)

- Create a **simple ripple/wavy pattern** using double crochets (DC)
- Alternate increases and decreases to form soft waves
- Each “wave peak” is formed by multiple DC increases
- Each “valley” is formed by DC decreases

Repeat until panel height reaches about **14 inches**

💡 Tip: Keep your tension even so the waves stay consistent.

Step 2: Add the Scalloped Border

Switch to **Lilac yarn** and smaller hook if needed.

Work along the top edge:

Pattern repeat:

- **SC, HDC, 3 DC, HDC, SC**

Between scallops:

- Add **Picot Stitch** for decorative points:
 - Chain 3, slip stitch into first chain

This creates a soft, decorative scalloped edge.

Step 3: Create the Appliqués

You will make **lavender stalks, flowers, and leaves separately**, then attach them.

Lavender Stalks

Using Lavender yarn:

1. Chain a long length for the stem
2. Work **Popcorn Stitch (PC)** clusters along the chain
3. Between clusters, use chain stitches to space them
4. Slip stitch down the chain to secure

Repeat to make multiple stalks.

Small Flowers

Use Lilac, White, or Dark Purple yarn.

1. Start with a **Magic Ring (MR)**
2. Inside the ring, repeat:
 - CH 3
 - Cluster stitch (CL)
 - CH 3
 - Slip stitch into ring
3. Make **5 petals total**

Pull ring tight and fasten off.

Leaves

Using Spring Green yarn:

1. Chain 6
2. Work back along chain:
 - SC
 - HDC
 - DC
 - HDC
 - SC

This forms one leaf shape.

Make multiple leaves.

Step 4: Assembly

Now bring everything together.

1. Lay your base panel flat
2. Arrange lavender stalks evenly across the panel
3. Add leaves at the base of each stalk
4. Place flowers between or near stalks

Attach all pieces using:

- Yarn needle
- Invisible stitching technique

 Take your time positioning for a balanced look.

Step 5: Tassels & Dangles

Tassels

1. Wrap yarn around your hand or a card
2. Tie at the top
3. Cut the bottom loops
4. Wrap yarn near the top to form tassel head

Attach tassels evenly along the bottom edge.

Hanging Dangles

1. Chain a length (approx. 4 inches)
2. Attach small flowers or leaves at the end
3. Secure to the base panel between tassels

Alternate colors for a playful effect 



Stitch Guide (Quick Reference)

- **CH** – Chain
- **SC** – Single Crochet
- **HDC** – Half Double Crochet
- **DC** – Double Crochet
- **TR** – Treble Crochet
- **SL ST** – Slip Stitch
- **PC** – Popcorn Stitch
- **CL** – Cluster Stitch
- **P** – Picot



Final Touch

- Check all ends are woven in securely
- Lightly block your piece for a clean finish
- Hang and enjoy your handmade lavender valance
