




#### PHASE 1: PREPARATION & LAYOUT [PREPARAÇÃO E DISPOSIÇÃO]

**\*\* PATCHWORK [PATCHWORK]:**  
Stitching fabric shapes together to form a surface.


**\*\* DOLL STUFFING [ENCHIMENTO DE BONECA]:**  
Using fiberfill to shape and firm the doll.

#### PHASE 4: DRESS ASSEMBLY [MONTAGEM DO VESTIDO]




**\*\* APLIQUÉ [APLIQUÉ]:**  
Attaching smaller fabric shapes (like the pigtail bows) onto a base fabric.

## PATCHWORK SEWING PATTERN

This detailed tutorial will guide you through creating a beautiful patchwork doll from start to finish using the exact structure and measurements shown in the pattern. Perfect for beginners and experienced crafters alike, this project combines sewing, patchwork, and simple assembly techniques.

## Materials and Tools

Before starting, gather the following:

- Cotton fabrics (various colors/patterns for patchwork)
- Skin-tone fabric for the doll body
- Yarn (for hair)
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Matching sewing threads
- Sewing needle or sewing machine
- Fabric scissors
- Pins or clips
- Fabric marker or chalk
- Ruler (centimeters)
- Iron

## Pattern Pieces and Measurements

Cut your fabric according to these measurements:

- **Head (cut 2 pieces):** 7 cm x 7 cm
- **Hair (cut 2 pieces):** 11 cm x 9 cm
- **Bow (cut 2 pieces):** 5 cm x 9 cm
- **Body base:** 6.5 cm x 7.5 cm
- **Dress (front + back):** approx. 14 cm wide x 12 cm tall

Make sure to include a **1 cm seam allowance** on all pieces.

## Preparation and Layout

Start by preparing your materials:

- Pre-wash and iron all fabrics to prevent shrinking later
- Lay out all pattern pieces on your fabric
- Trace each shape carefully using chalk or a fabric pen
- Cut all pieces accurately following the pattern outlines

Keeping everything organized at this stage will make the process much smoother.

## Patchwork Assembly

Now it's time to create the patchwork fabric for the dress:

- Cut small fabric squares in coordinating colors
- Arrange them in a grid layout (as shown in the pattern)
- Sew squares together row by row
- Press seams flat with an iron
- Join rows to form a complete patchwork panel

This panel will be used to cut the dress shape later.

## Dress Construction

Using your patchwork panel:

1. Place the dress pattern over the patchwork fabric
2. Cut **1 front piece and 1 back piece**
3. Sew shoulder seams together
4. Attach sleeves (if included in your version)
5. Sew side seams
6. Fold and stitch the neckline neatly
7. Hem the bottom edge of the dress

Turn the dress right side out and press it flat.

## Doll Body Assembly

### Step 1: Head

- Place the two head pieces right sides together
- Sew around the edge, leaving a small opening
- Turn right side out
- Stuff firmly with fiberfill
- Close the opening with a hidden stitch

## Step 2: Body and Limbs

- Sew the body pieces together
- Attach arms and legs (if separate pieces are included)
- Turn everything right side out
- Stuff evenly to give shape

## Step 3: Attach Head

- Sew the head securely onto the body using strong stitches



## Hair and Bow

### Hair

- Take the two hair pieces and sew them together
- Attach yarn strands evenly across the head
- Style into pigtails as shown
- Secure with stitches

### Bow

- Sew the bow pieces together
- Turn right side out and shape
- Attach to the hair using stitches



## Facial Features

Using embroidery or fabric paint:

- Stitch or draw two small eyes
- Add a simple curved smile
- Lightly apply blush to the cheeks for a cute finish

Keep the face minimal for a soft handmade look.



## **Final Assembly**

- Dress the doll by sliding the dress onto the body
- Secure the dress with a few stitches if needed
- Adjust hair, bows, and overall shape



## **Finishing Touches**

- Check all seams for strength
- Trim any loose threads
- Give the doll a final press if needed
