

# Complete Amigurumi Dragon Crochet Tutorial

Create your own adorable dragon from start to finish with this detailed guide! This pattern uses US crochet terminology and follows the structure shown in the diagram so you can confidently complete every part.

## COMPLETE AMIGURUMI DRAGON CROCHET GUIDE: Step-by-Step for

### 1. The Head & Eyes (PINK)

### 5. Spine & Horns (DARK PURPLE)

### MATERIALS

- Yarn: Pink, Dark Purple, Cream/Beige (specific types)
- Safety Eyes
- Polyfill
- 3.25mm Hook
- Yarn Needle

### MAIN STITCHES & METHODS (US Terms)

- SC: Single Crochet** (insert, yo, pull, yo, through 2)
- HDC: Half Double Crochet** (yo, insert, yo, pull, yo, through all 3)
- DC: Double Crochet** (yo, insert, yo, pull, yo, through 2, yo, through 2)
- INC: Increase** (2 SC in 1 st)
- INV-DEC: Invisible Decrease** (insert through front loops of next 2, yo, pull, yo, through 2)
- FLO/BLO: Front/Back Loop Only** (visual)
- MR: Magic Ring** (visual start)
- Bobble Stitch** (visual process)
- Bobble Stitch** (visual process)
- FSC: Foundation Single Crochet**

Litch the moan-pach paths. Stitling the underiane stitching toe stitching.

## Materials You'll Need

- Yarn: Pink, Dark Purple, Cream/Beige
- Safety eyes
- Polyfill stuffing
- 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle



## Abbreviations (US Terms)

- SC: Single Crochet (insert, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2)
- HDC: Half Double Crochet (yarn over, insert, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through all 3)
- DC: Double Crochet
- INC: Increase (2 SC in same stitch)
- INV-DEC: Invisible Decrease
- FLO/BLO: Front Loop Only / Back Loop Only
- MR: Magic Ring
- Bobble Stitch: multiple stitches in one space for texture
- FSC: Foundation Single Crochet



## 1. Head & Eyes (Pink)

Start with the head using a Magic Ring.

Round 1: MR, 6 SC

Round 2: INC around (12)

Round 3: (SC, INC) repeat (18)

Round 4: (2 SC, INC) repeat (24)

Round 5–10: SC around

Shape the snout by slightly elongating the front using a few extra SC rows if needed.

Place safety eyes between rounds 6–8, spaced evenly. Add embroidered eyelashes if desired.

Continue:

Round 11: (2 SC, INV-DEC) repeat

Round 12: (SC, INV-DEC) repeat

Stuff firmly and close.



## 2. Torso & Belly (Cream & Pink)

Start from the bottom with cream yarn.

Round 1: MR, 6 SC

Round 2: INC around (12)

Round 3: (SC, INC) repeat (18)

Round 4–8: SC around

Switch to pink yarn for the body sides while keeping the belly cream (work color changes as you go).

Round 9–15: SC around maintaining belly panel

Stuff as you go to keep shape firm but soft.



## 3. Limbs & Paws (Pink)

Make 4 legs.

Round 1: MR, 6 SC

Round 2: INC around (12)

Round 3–6: SC around

Shape the foot by slightly flattening the bottom. Add small cream or beige claws using short yarn stitches or embroidery.

Stuff lightly and leave a tail for sewing.



## 4. Wings & Tail (Pink with Purple Spine)

### Wings:

Chain a base row.

Row 1: DC across

Row 2: HDC back

Use increases at edges to create a curved wing shape.

Add structure by working in FLO on some rows for ribbing detail.

## **Tail:**

Start with MR:

Round 1: 6 SC

Round 2: SC around

Gradually increase every few rounds to widen slightly.

Add bobble stitches along the tail for decorative bumps.

## **5. Spine & Horns (Dark Purple)**

### **Spine:**

Attach yarn along the back of the dragon.

Use HDC stitches in a row, forming small peaks by chaining and slipping stitches.

### **Horns:**

MR, 4 SC

Work 4–6 rounds of SC to form cones

Stuff lightly and fasten off

Make 2 horns.

## **6. Final Assembly**

Sew all parts together carefully.

- Attach head to torso securely
- Sew legs evenly on both sides
- Attach wings to upper back
- Sew horns on top of head
- Attach spine along the back and tail

Use a yarn needle and stitch through both loops for durability.

Stuff and shape as needed while assembling to keep proportions balanced.

## 7. Decorative Mat (Optional)

Create a floral mat base:

Round 1: MR, 12 DC

Round 2: INC in each stitch

Round 3+: Add petal shapes using chains and slip stitches

Use cream yarn for the base and pink/green for flowers and leaves.

### Final Tips

- Keep stitches tight to avoid gaps
- Stuff gradually for best shape
- Use stitch markers to track rounds
- Take your time assembling—this makes a big difference in the final look
